There are music shows, craft shops, food and rides all through the park. Be sure to visit the Dolly Parton Museum that traces Dolly’s rise to stardom. This evening we again have reserved seats at the Hatfield and McCoy Dinner and Music Show. (B, DS)

Day #4 | Thursday, October 18, 2012

This morning, we head into the heart of the Great Smoky Mountain National Park. Picture stops will be made along the way as we head for Asheville, North Carolina. Our destination

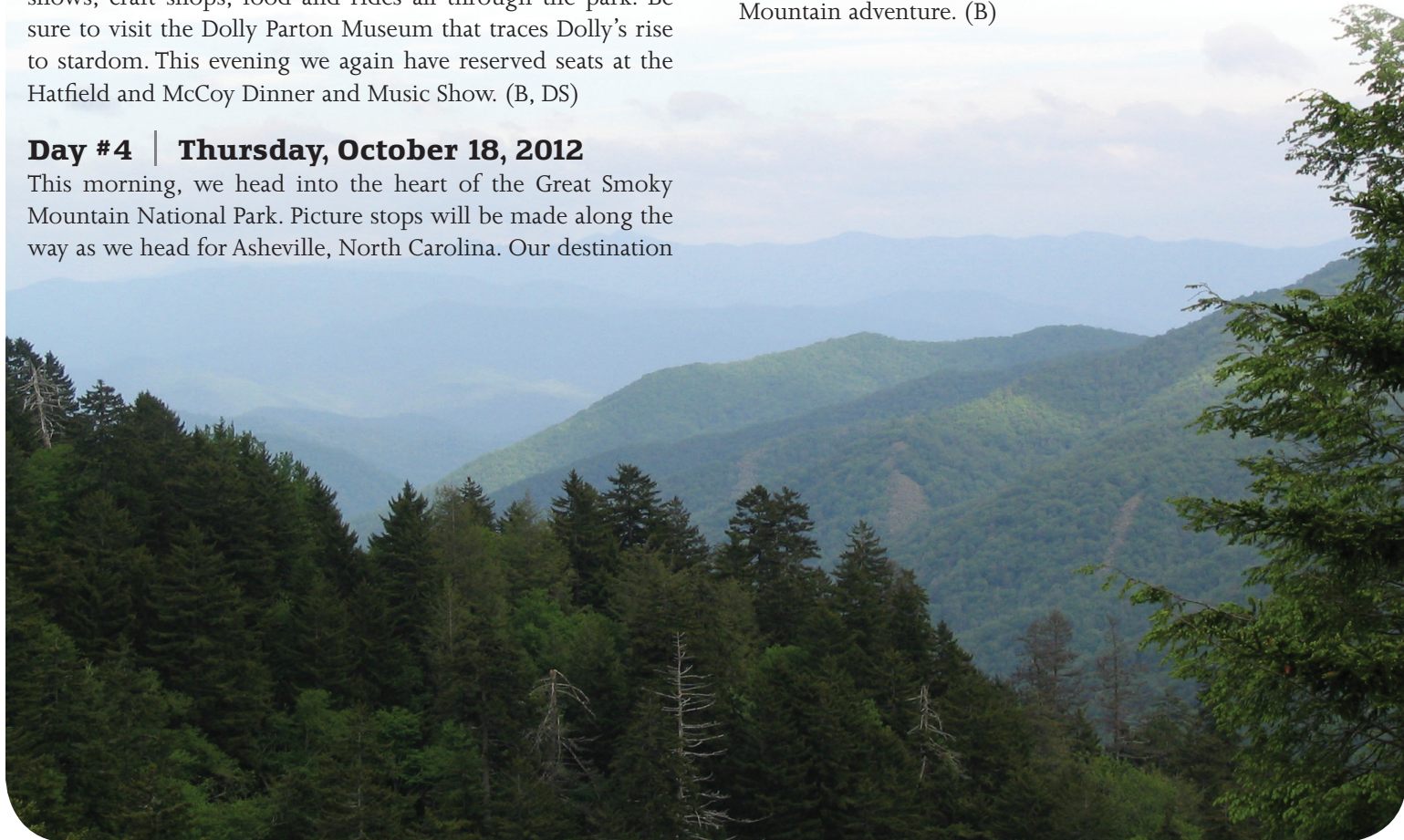
is the Biltmore House. Construction began in 1889 and completed in 1895. The house was built by George W Vanderbilt and is surrounded by an 8000 acre estate. Here we will have lunch and the opportunity to visit the house and the gardens in all their autumn glory. We then return to Gatlinburg to freshen up and have dinner. This evening, we have reserved seats at the Country Tonight Show. (B, L)

Day #5 | Friday, October 19, 2012

Regretfully, we must depart Gatlinburg and head north. Our destination is Nashville, Music City USA. Along the way, a stop will be made in Knoxville at the Botanical Gardens. The gardens are located on 44 acres and feature walking trails, finished gardens, and unique and historic horticulture. After our visit we head for Nashville. Upon our arrival, we will make a visit to the world famous “Country Music Hall of Fame”. We then check into our hotel to freshen up for tonight we have reserved seats at the world famous “Grand Ole Opry”. (B)
